Terms and Conditions for a Skill at Arms display

What you may expect of us:

We, the Light Cavalry HAC, will furnish a Skill at Arms (SAA) team of normally four riders, and not less than three, who will demonstrate the use of mounted lance and sword drills for approximately 30 minutes. Up to two displays can be performed each day with a gap of at least an hour between displays. The SAA team will be supported by an arena party and commentator and will be pleased to undertake special requests for photographic or display purposes by prior arrangement.

What is expected from you:

The Light Cavalry requires a minimum contribution of £1,500 per day toward the running costs of the charity. In addition, for venues within the London emission control zone, there will be a charge for horse transport. The total amount due will be invoiced after the event.

You are responsible for providing a safe and secure location for loading, unloading and securing the horses and the horsebox with access to water for the horses. You should also provide a safe route to and from the SAA area. The display area should be at least 20m by 80m, with a suitable equestrian surface, ideally grass and be fenced to prevent the public from getting into the display area. Though the Light Cavalry has public liability insurance we require copies of your show risk assessment and PL insurance policy certificate as well as assurance that First Aid cover will be provided.
