ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

- a. A limited number of King's Troop horses will be available for non-horsed entrants/ units. Early application is advised.
- b. The King's Troop and the HAC reserve the right to invite competitors riding King's Troop horses to withdraw from these competitions if their standard of riding is not considered to be acceptable.
- c. Competitors must ensure they fully understand the nature and rules of the competitions that they are entering and observe the etiquette for BSJA events in both the arena and the collecting ring.
- d. All competitors and spectators/ guests must give their names to the show secretary beforehand, bring personal photo ID with them and comply with King's Troop orders regarding movement around and activities within the barracks.
- e. Those bringing their own horses must bring their **horse vaccination certificates**.
- f. It is a requirement of The King's Troop RHA that **all competitors** read & sign their copy of the **disclaimer form**. Team Captains / individuals **must** ensure that this form is returned together with their entry form and the appropriate cheque made payable to "The Light Cavalry HAC".
