This competition is open to teams and individuals currently serving with Regular and Reserve units from the UK and other countries. The King's Troop has very kindly made some of their horses available to be ridden by non-horsed units (early application advisable).

Class 1 — Equimax team show jumping competition for the Richard Edmondston-Low Challenge Cup

Entries in advance. Teams of four; best three scores count. Judged under BSJA Rule 281. Two rounds. Competitors eliminated in the first round will jump in the second round. In the event of equality of faults there will be a jump off against the clock to determine the team and individual winners. The order of jumping will be drawn and the show secretary and collecting ring stewards will have the drawn order. All "own horse" competitors will go last. For hired horses, jumps will not exceed 2'9" / 84cms in the first round. For competitors with their own horses, jumps will not exceed 3'3" / 100cms in the first round. Fences may be raised for the second round.

Class 2 — The Hugh Auger 'fault and out' competition.

For individual riders. Judged under BSJA rules – Table A. All riders are deemed to have entered this competition unless they withdraw by informing the show secretary. The starting order will be drawn. Three points are scored for each obstacle jumped clear. One point is scored for a jump attempted but knocked down. You have 60 seconds to amass as many points as you can. If the competitor completes the round without error then the clock is stopped when the competitor crosses the finishing line. If a jump is knocked down the competitor must cross the finishing line in either direction and only then is the clock stopped. In the event of any other error the bell is rung to terminate the round and the time is not recorded. There is only one round and those with their own horses will go last; the fences will be raised for them.

Please note: The King's Troop and the HAC reserve the right to invite competitors riding King's Troop horses to withdraw from these competitions if their standard of riding is not appropriate.

- 1) Competitors must wear uniform and also skull headgear which complies with BS EN 1384: 1997 specification or equivalent.
- 2) Each competitor must sign their own copy of the disclaimer notice. These forms must be returned with your Team / Individual entry form.
- 3) Do not forget to bring personal photo ID with you and, for those competitors bringing their own horse(s), in addition their horse vaccination certificates.
- 4) Entries will not be accepted without the appropriate entry fee payable to The Light Cavalry HAC (LC HAC)

Following the competition a celebratory mess dinner will be held that evening at Armoury House, City Road, London, EC1Y 2BQ (the HQ of the HAC). Please go to the Light Cavalry HAC website for details or ask the show secretary— <http://www.lchac.org.uk/>
